Policing

Nothing particular to report! Hard facts have not been collated for this month, but in general, nothing obvious on street level- the smart water property marking system is being trialled on Berens Road. (Berens chosen as having higher burglary record.) More is going on than actually reported – judging by police going door to door PLEASE report everything that happens to the police.

Following a report to the meeting last month re: youths congregating on Harrow Road – no one else seems to know about it, but if you see a problem, continue to report it. Burglary continues to be a problem, do take precautions: 5 burglaries in Triangle in past 3 weeks; poor security a factor in many. A scooter has been stolen, and a mugging reported!

Please report suspicious behaviour. Often it is dodgy, so do not hesitate.

Don't lend anyone a ladder!

Triangle is not the only targeted area – Lonsdale Road gets clobbered regularly. We will put neighbourhood policing contact details on our noticeboard.

Streetcare and Cleansing

Harrow Road Flood! Thames Water are responsible for flood drains, but the Council will back you up on any push against Thames Water. RBK&C did come and clear the drains after the first flood, and it has not flooded again.

Trees

Berens Road notice of major tree works only appeared the day before – Dave tried to get information, as he did not want it felled. Officers agreed to stop felling – but did not say whether the tree was due to be felled or not. Information has been a problem – it has been agreed that we should get 2 weeks notice before any felling – if you think it is going to happen, get onto Simon Green., and he will take action. There is a waiting list for new tree planting across borough. Agitate for notice for details for all tree works.

Tree on Rainham Road cut down by mistake - still has not been replanted.
